Pro Tools 101

PT101 - Introduction to Pro Tools

Prerequisites: Basic computer skills, some audio recording knowledge, some Pro Tools familiarity and a good knowledge of the English language. **Pro Tools 101: Introduction to Pro Tools** is intended as a prerequisite for taking the 110 course. Passing the 101 exam is required before taking the 110 exam.
